ZOOM! COMPETITION RULES

1. The competition will be called **Zoom!** and will seek out photographic images of excellence from young carers in the United Kingdom.
2. Entries from young carers can be about any aspect of their lives, and must be submitted by 4.00 pm on **14 May 2008**, together with the official application/permission form.
3. The photograph must be taken by the young carer submitting the entry. Photographs will not be returned. No expenses incurred in taking or submitting photographs will be met by Carers Week.
4. Each young carer can submit 2 separate entries.
5. By entering the competition you agree that your entry can appear on public display. Carers Week may also use the photos on the internet, television, and in print to promote carers issues (in newspapers and magazines for example) and share them with our partners and supporters of this competition.
6. There will be two age categories for the competition: under 13 and 13-18 (as at 14 May 2008). The judges will select a winner from each category.
7. The judges (Anne Begg MP; John McGrohan, MS Society; Paul Matz, Carers Week Manager) will also select up to 10 other entries as national/regional winners
8. A full list of the prize winners will appear on the Carers Week website.

The two overall winners of the competition will each receive a fantastic package of prizes including the sleek **Panasonic Lumix DMC-FX100EB-K Digital Camera**, which arrives with 12.2 megapixels so images remain clear and sharp. Other features include the Easy Zoom Button which enables you to secure faraway shots in conjunction with the 3.6 x active zoom, a high quality

28mm wide-angle LEICA DC lens, a built-in Mega Optical Image Stabiliser and the Venus Engine III processor which allows the continuous shooting of photos until the memory card fills up.
